Transportation Department - Discipline Plan

Class "A" Infractions

Class "A" infractions are (but not limited to):

- Eating, drinking on the bus
- Throwing objects
- Inappropriate language
- Inappropriate behavior
- Pushing/shoving
- Failure to respond to a reasonable request
- Disruptive behavior, not flagrant
- Unsafe behavior, routine

These infractions will be handled in this manner:

- 1. First write-up: Parent/guardian must sign to get student back on the bus (route and/or activity).
- 2. Second write-up: Parent/guardian must sign to get student back on bus, the supervisor will call to speak with parent/guardian.
- 3. Third write-up: A meeting between, parent, student, supervisor and administrator to decide if student will be able to continue to ride buses.

Class "B" Infractions

Class "B" infractions are (but not limited to):

- Disruptive behavior, flagrant
- Unsafe behavior, flagrant
- Profanity, vulgar language or gestures
- ❖ Insubordination
- Tobacco and/or drug use on the bus

These infractions will be handled in this manner:

1. Automatic one day off of route and/or activity bus.

The third infraction of this type will result in meeting with parent/guardian, student, supervisor and administrator, to decide if the student will be able to continue to ride buses.

Class "C" Infractions

Class "C" infractions are (but not limited to):

- Fighting
- Threats, harassment, bullying
- Damage to school property
- ❖ Theft
- ❖ Sexual harassment
- Extortion/coercion
- ❖ Arson
- Vandalism

These infractions will be handled in this manner:

- Automatic three-day suspension from buses (route and/or activity). If there is property damage, the student/parent will be required to pay for damages.
 Parents/guardians will receive notification from the supervisor. Parents may set up a meeting with the supervisor and administration if desired.
- 2. Second infraction of this type will result in a meeting with parent, student, supervisor and administrator to decide if the student will be able to continue to ride buses.

Class "D" Infractions

Class "D" infractions are (but not limited to):

- Assault physical or sexual
- Possession or use of alcohol, drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Willful destruction or defacing of school property, vandalism
- Creating a threat of physical harm to others
- Selling drugs
- Robbery or felony theft
- Sexual harassment, physical

These infractions will be handled in this manner:

1. Automatic three-day suspension with meeting with parent, student, supervisor and administrators. This could result in students being suspended for the school year from all buses (route and/or activity).

Class "E" Infractions

Class "E" infractions are (but not limited to):

- ❖ Bomb threat
- Weapons
- ❖ Criminal assault
- Any violation which would be a felony if committed by an adult

These infractions will be handled in this manner:

1. Suspension from buses (route and/or activity) for the year, pending a meeting with parents/guardians, student, supervisor and administration.

ALL OF THE ABOVE INFRACTIONS COULD HAVE ADDITIONAL DISCIPLINE ACTION FROM BUILDING PRINCIPALS.
