

## Admissions and Gate Receipts

All district employees and members of the board of education, accompanied by one family member, and all persons acting or serving in an official capacity (supervisors, sponsors, gate collectors, scorekeepers, etc.) shall be admitted free of charge to athletic events.

In addition, the following persons shall be admitted free of charge to athletic events:

1. All cheerleaders and pompom girls in uniform.
2. All students participating in a seasonal sport, e.g., students participating in a fall sport shall be admitted free during the fall season and students participating in a winter sport shall be admitted free during the winter season.
3. All band members when the band is performing during an athletic event.

Otherwise, K-12 students shall have to pay when attending senior high school athletic events. Elementary students must be supervised and will not be admitted if unaccompanied by an adult.

Students when assigned to work the concession stand shall be allowed into athletic events free of charge provided there shall be a limited number of students allowed for each event.

All senior citizens (age 60 years and up) of the community shall be admitted free of charge to athletic events.

NOTE: Admissions will be charged and updated as needed.
